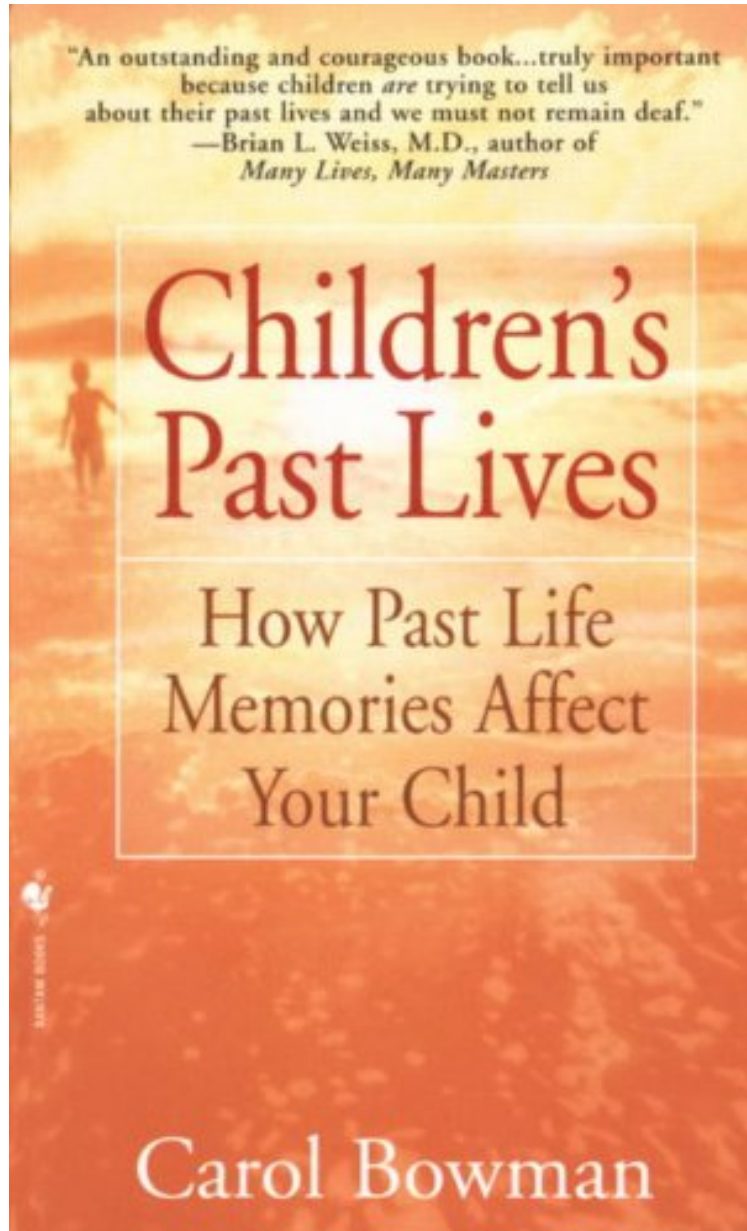

Each section is broken down into bite-size sub-sections of a few pages. Section #I is biographical in nature. She tells how she became interested in this topic and how she researched the topic.
