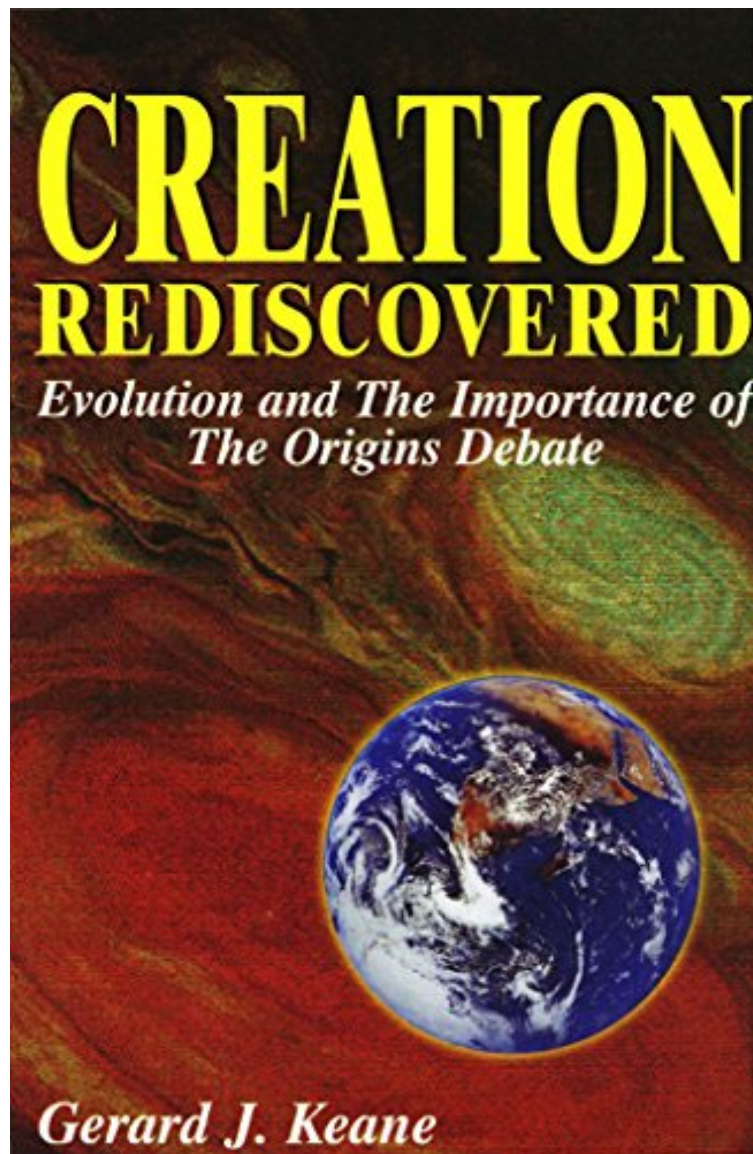

For example, a bird's wings (or flying reptile's) have to be perfectly designed for them to function. A prototype wing, that couldn't really bring flight, would have no reason to be 'selected' for further development. In fact, it would make the animal more likely to be encumbered and a prey to other animals. According to the book, scientists are searching for some other mechanism of evolution, so far unsuccessfully. They cannot solve the riddle of proteins and DNA. Proteins are highly complex structures whose growth and development are controlled by DNA. But the formation of DNA itself requires proteins. Then how could proteins 'evolve' unless there was DNA present. But the DNA cannot develop unless proteins are present. Neither could come first because they both need each other. The book also talks about the mutation issue. At best only one in ten thousand genetic mutations is NOT harmful. Genetic changes due to mutations therefore could not account for an improvement in the species, but actually would cause it's decline, since negative carryovers far outweigh the positive. Finally the book explains why teaching evolution as a proven fact is dangerous, by showing that belief in evolution is a common denominator of Nazism, Communism, Secular Humanism, Existentialism and Modernism.
