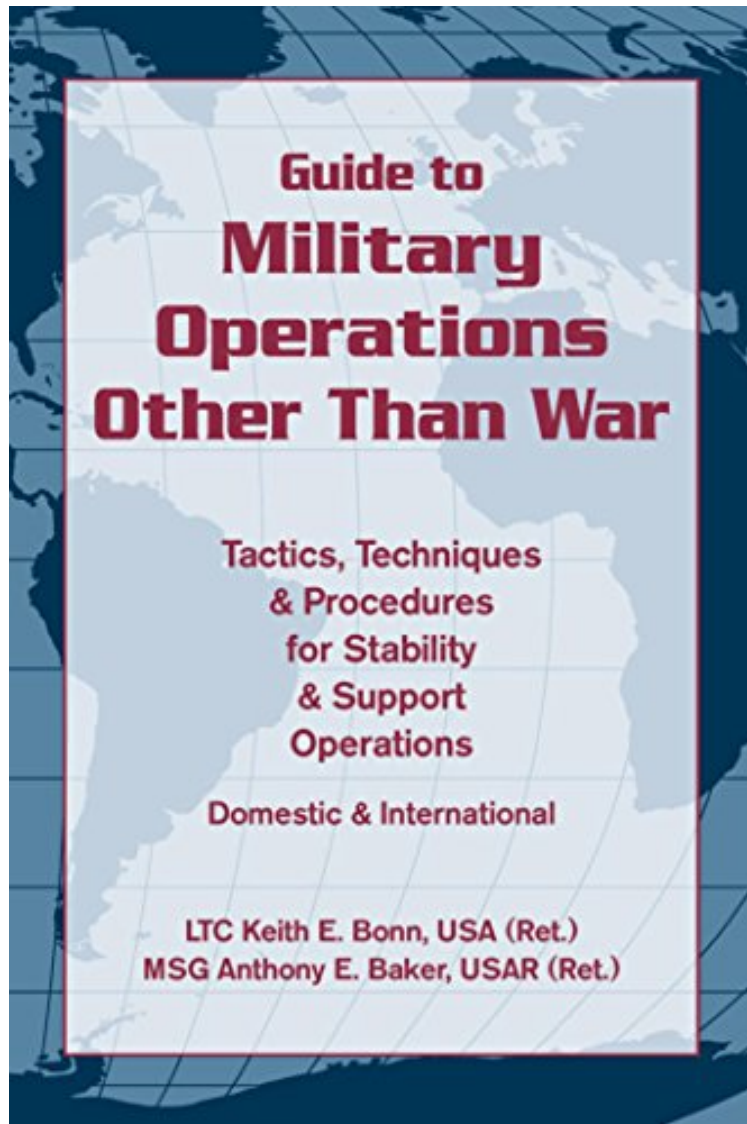

Bonn and Baker have solved this problem with this wonderfully written and doctrinally correct volume that stipulates from A to Z all aspects of planning, directing, and executing MOOTW. It prescribes "the skills and attitudes essential for success at the tactical and operational levels in these increasingly important and common political-military endeavor." It is the first book to cover on-the-ground functions, such as working with international and interagency task forces; methods of coordination; rules of engagement; checkpoints; civilian population and movement control; evacuating noncombatants; distributing humanitarian aid; operating dislocated civilian camps; providing medical care; conducting cordons and searches; disarming belligerents; confiscating hostile weapons and equipment; conducting negotiations; exchanging prisoners; interacting with the media; and dozens of other military and civil support type operations. Without this book doctrine continues to be stagnate. In fact, doctrine has not really moved forward since 1994, when the last TRADOC Pam 525-5 was published. Hence Stackpole had the insight to agree that Bonn and Baker provide, quite frankly, a panacea for what the Military has been struggling with for nearly a decade.
