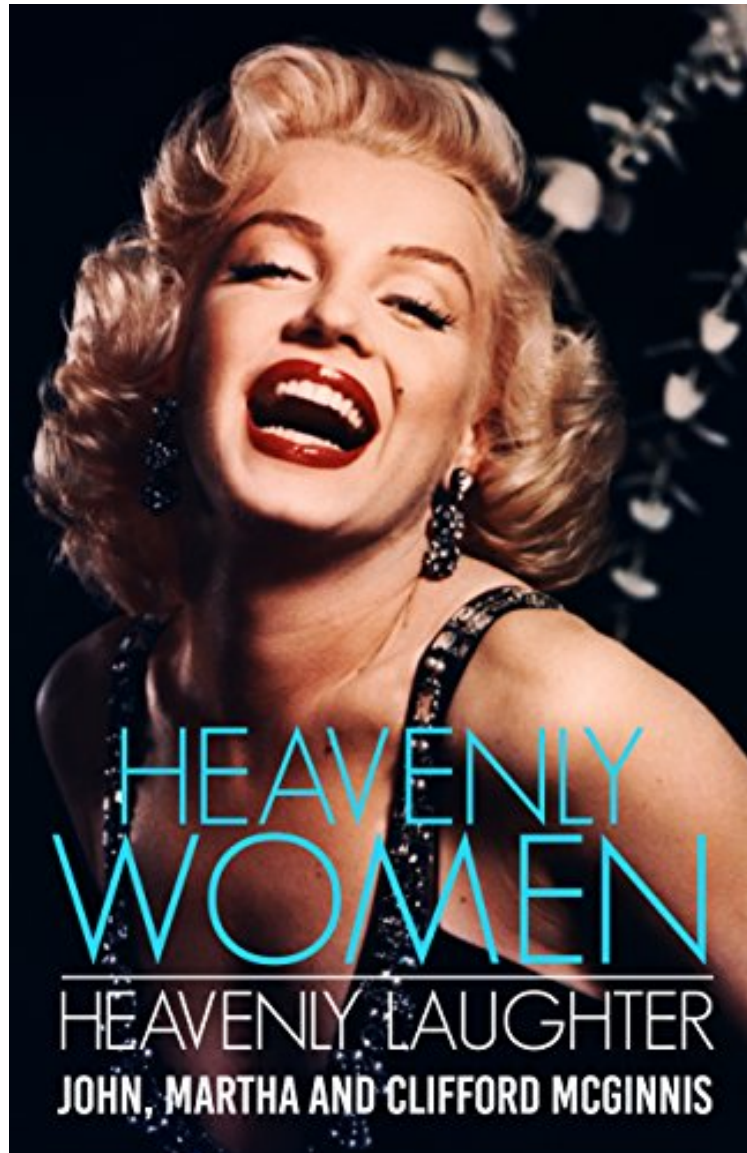

With the interpretation of the word heavenly taking us from the celebrity of Marilyn Monroe to the austerity and counter-materialism of Saint Clare of Assisi, before moving to Eleanor Roosevelt. But it didn't stop there; further interviews were provided with a host of characters, male and female: philosophers, comedians, writers and scientists. The book is filled with contrasts while continuing the trends set by earlier ones in the series. These contrasts may appear a strange mix, but the diverse characters have the common thread of counsel from those with experience and a calibre of authority - people who have earned a right to be listened to. What they had to say had depth and importance to their time and to current society - a combination of reflection, interpretation and commentary. It had a meaning, authority and gravitas to make it worthy of reading, whether or not you believe in the concept of spiritual readings. My own beliefs, and to a large extent lack of them, means I can not readily accept the concept of readings with these great figures.
