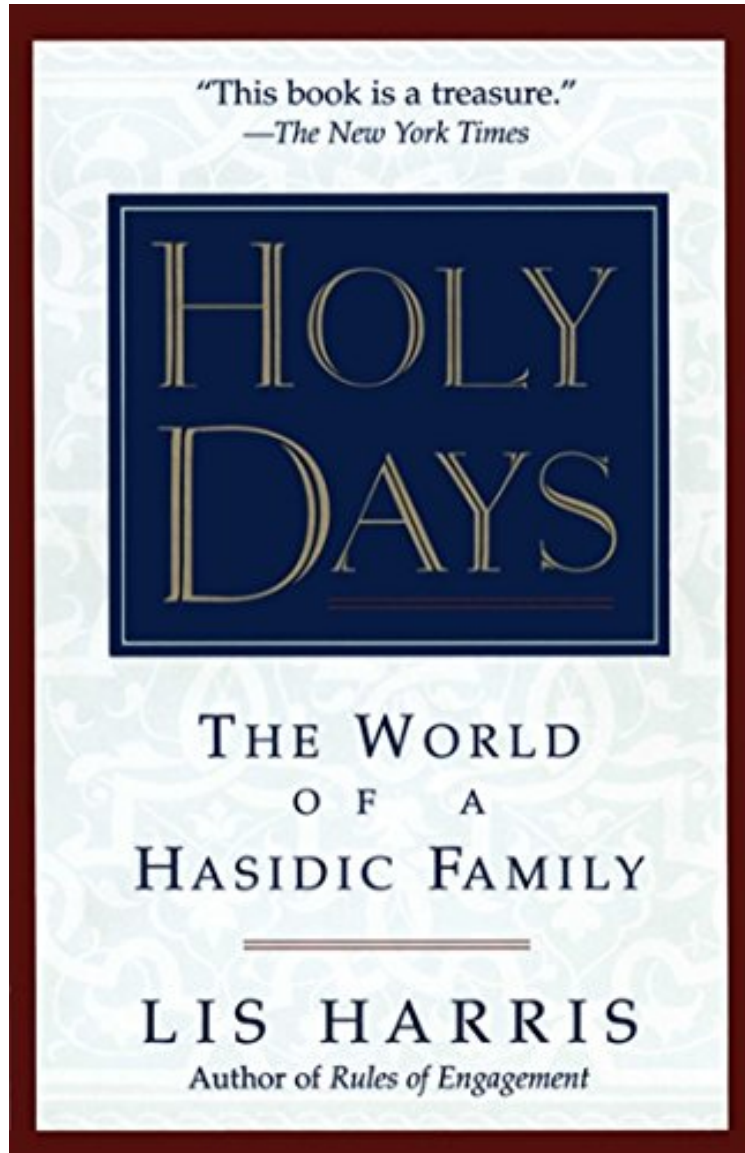

available (it is, in paperback). The author overcame initial resistance to her presence and established enough trust to give a detailed and often moving description of the particulars of Hasidic home life, particularly women's experiences of it. Most especially I recall a beautiful chapter on the mikvah (ritual bath). With a good deal of grace, the author includes a lot of her own mixed responses to the respectfulness and restrictions directed toward women in Hasidic culture.
