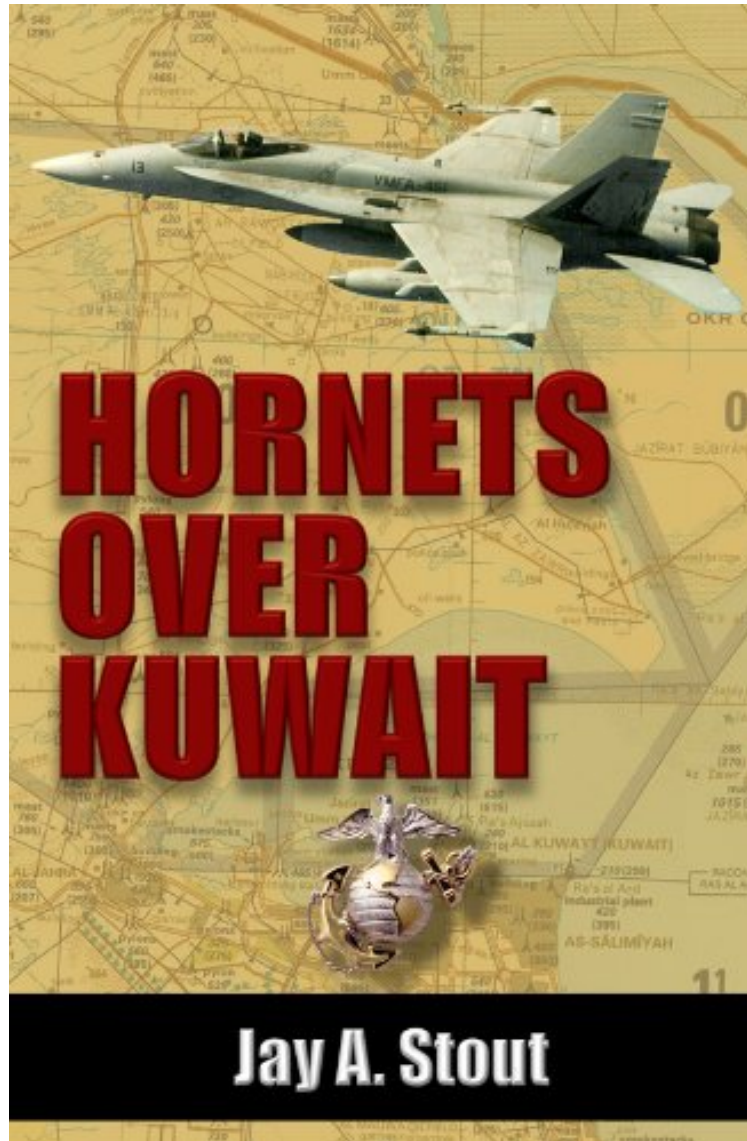

In "Hornets over Kuwait" I found again his lively style full of humour and self derision. I loved his

description of the F/A-18 Hornet that I flew myself in the Swiss Air Force: his very accurate description is easy to understand even for non aviators. I only disagree with his very negative appreciation of female pilots. When I was CINC Swiss Air Force I opened the door to young women to become military pilots and the result was just outstanding.
